

## <u>CPCCOHS1001A Work safely in the construction industry</u> <u>Course Description</u>

| Course details          | Statistics on 19th June 2015 show that there have been 73 fatalities so far as a result of accidents in the workplace in Australia. The White Card course in NSW is designed to raise  |
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|                         | awareness of best practices to eliminate risks that cause injuries and fatalities in the work place.<br>To work in the Construction Industry, you need to complete a White Card course to do so.   |
|                         | This course requires the ability to demonstrate personal awareness of Work Health & Safety (WHS) legislative requirements, and the basic principles of risk management and prevention of injury and illness in the construction industry.                      |
|                         | This course covers the basic WHS knowledge required prior to commencing work tasks within any of the sectors of the construction industry.   |
| <u>Training Program</u> | All students are required to arrive 30min before the course start time for registration and ID check. Any student who is more than 10min late will not be accepted into the course.  |

|                         | 2. Practical training in the classroom   |
|                         | 3. Assessment for both knowledge and skills  |
|                         | This course is licenced through SafeWork NSW and we must deliver the program as per their requirements which include:  |
|                         | All students must have 100 points of ID on the day of training   |
|                         | <ul> <li>Training must be conducted over a minimum period of 6hrs not including breaks</li> <li>A Statement of Training (SOT) must be issued to students if they satisfactorily complete all assessments, demonstrating competency in the program.</li> </ul>  |
|                         | An SOT is valid for 60 days after the date issued. With this, students can go onto any worksite immediately after the course.  |
|                         | Student who do not bring 100 points of ID on the day will not be accepted into the course and will have to rebook, paying 50% of the course cost.  |
| Cost & Location         | The cost for this program is \$120 per person.   |
|                         | Course delivered in Sydney, Parramatta and Dee Why for public.   |
|                         | This program is available for group bookings or onsite training across NSW.  |
| <u>Pre requisites</u>   | This course combines plain English, videos, photos, and questioning to ensure all learners are   |

| <u>Assessment</u>       | Students will be assessed during the classroom session. Assessment will confirm knowledge and skills have been achieved to demonstrate competency across the unit.   |

|                                  | If a student is not successful in completing all assessments satisfactorily, they will need to rebook the course at the full course fee.   |
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| Certification                    | Once a competent mark is awarded, learners will be issued with a Statement of Attainment for<br>CPCCOHS1001A Work safely in the construction industry. This Unit of Competency is Nationally<br>Recognised Training from Construction, Plumbing and Services Training Package.<br>Certificates are emailed to students however hard copy is available for additional fee.  |
| Recognition of prior<br>learning | Students choosing to undertake RPL will need to be sent an RPL guide for their course. To request an RPL guide, please <u>contact our team</u> .<br>In order to be eligible for RPL, the student must demonstrate currency in that particular subject. i.e. a student cannot submit evidence from 5 years prior and request it be applied directly to their new competency. They must show how they have since applied those skills and that they are current, including any practical skills associated to the program. |
